1999 IDAHO FACTS AT A GLANCE

" Crime Rate

- 10.9% decrease from 1998 of the statewide crime rate calculated by the NIBRS Group "A" offenses.
- 6,827 per 100,000 inhabitants based on NIBRS Group "A" offenses.
- 3,189 per 100,000 inhabitants based on summary index offense, which is utilized for comparison purposes with other states.

" Arrests

- 6% decrease in total arrests.
- 72,730 total arrests reported.
- 5809.1 arrest rate per 100,000 population.

" Hate Crime

- 42.1% decrease of hate crime.
- 33 reported incidents in 1999.
- 36.4% of hate crime incidents were racially motivated.

" Law Enforcement Officers Assaulted

- no officers killed in the line of duty.
- 14.1% decrease of assaults on Idaho law enforcement officers.
- 232 total assaults on officers.

" "Group A" Crime

- 9.2% decrease in total offenses.





TOTAL GROUP "A" CRIME 5 Year Trend













IDAHO URBAN/RURAL CRIME IN 1999

U.S. Census Bureau defines urban as incorporated cities with a population of 2,500 or more. Rural is defined as cities with a population less than 2,500 and unincorporated county areas. County areas adjacent to a large city and with a population density of at least 1,000 persons per square mile may be considered urban based on percentage of urban/rural. The Department of Commerce provided data indicating urban/rural percentages for the counties of Idaho. For publication purposes, the reporting counties with an estimated 80% or more urbanization are calculated under the urban category in totality.




