

Crimes Against Persons in 2011 Gender Comparison






Murder Incidents by Type of Weapons Used in 2011











Aggravated Assault Incidents by Type of Weapons Used in 2011






Simple Assault Victims by Age in 2011



Victims of Intimidation by Age in 2011





Kidnapping/Abduction Victims by Age in 2011


