### **Statewide Profile**


#### Data counts represent the number of offenses within a reported incident





#### Arrests By Age in 2017







#### Adult Arrests Count 5 Year Trend




#### Drug/Narcotic Violations Count 5 Year Trend





#### Juvenile Arrests Count 5 Year Trend




#### Drug/Narcotic Violations Arrests By Age in 2017

20.91% increase from last years suspected drug and/or alcohol usage during the commission of Group "A" offenses.




## **Drug Equipment Violations**






#### Drug Equipment Violations Count 5 Year Trend




# **Gambling Offenses**



#### Gambling Offenses by Category







#### Pornography Offense by Category




#### Pornography/Obscene Material Count 5 Year Trend




#### Pornography/Obscene Material Arrests By Age in 2017



## **Prostitution Offenses**

#### - To unlawfully engage in or promote sexual activities for profit -

These offenses are categorized under two types of criminal activity: 1) Prostitution, which is to unlawfully engage in sexual relations for profit. 2) Assisting/promoting prostitution, which is defined as to solicit customers or transport persons for prostitution purposes; to own, manage, or operate a dwelling or other establishment for the purpose of providing a place where prostitution is performed; or to otherwise assist or promote prostitution.







#### Prostitution Offenses Arrests By Age in 2017







#### Type of Weapons Used


