









#### **Drug/Narcotic Violations Arrests By Age in 2018**



10.3% increase from last years suspected drug and/or alcohol usage during the commission of Group "A" offenses.




- The unlawful manufacture, sale, purchase, possession, or transportation of equipment or devices utilized in preparing and/or using drugs or narcotics -






#### Estimated Seized Value (in \$ 1,000s)


#### - To unlawfully engage in or promote sexual activities for profit -

These offenses are categorized under two types of criminal activity: 1) Prostitution, which is to unlawfully engage in sexual relations for profit. 2) Assisting/promoting prostitution, which is defined as to solicit customers or transport persons for prostitution purposes; to own, manage, or operate a dwelling or other establishment for the purpose of providing a place where prostitution is performed; or to otherwise assist or promote prostitution.






#### **Prostitution Offenses by Category**









#### Weapons Law Violations Arrests By Age in 2018






