


Total Crimes Against Persons 5 Year Trend





Frequency of Crime by Month



Victim Count of Murder by Age







Rape Count - 5 Year Trend









Sodomy Count - 5 Year Trend









Sexual Assault with an Object Count - 5 Year Trend





- The touching of the private body parts of another person for the purpose of sexual gratification, forcible and/or against that person's will; or not forcible or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent -

This offense is an element of rape, sodomy, and sexual assault with an object; therefore, only reported when it is the sole sex offense committed against a victim.





Kidnapping


- The unlawful seizure, transportation, and/or detention of a person against his/her will, or a minor without the consent of his/her parent(s) or legal guardian -

Although the object of a kidnapping may be to obtain money or property, kidnapping is a crime against persons. This offense includes not only kidnapping and abduction, but hostage taking as well. This category is intended to capture information on only the persons actually kidnapped or abducted, not those persons or organizations paying ransoms. Therefore, for each offense of kidnapping, the victims are only the persons taken or detained against their will.





Kidnapping Count - 5 Year Trend









Aggravated Assault Count - 5 Year Trend









Simple Assault Count - 5 Year Trend








Intimidation Count - 5 Year Trend






Incest Count - 5 Year Trend




