









Drug/Narcotic Violations Arrests By Age in 2019




Usage of Drugs and/or Alcohol

3.12% decrease from last years suspected drug and/or alcohol usage during the commission of Group "A" offenses.




- The unlawful manufacture, sale, purchase, possession, or transportation of equipment or devices utilized in preparing and/or using drugs or narcotics -

This offense includes the operation of 'meth labs.' Seized materials used to produce any illegal controlled substance would be classified under drug equipment violation.







Drug Equipment Violations Arrests By Age in 2019












Arrestee Age Distribution

Prostitution Offenses

- To unlawfully engage in or promote sexual activities for profit -

These offenses are categorized under two types of criminal activity: 1) Prostitution, which is to unlawfully engage in sexual relations for profit. 2) Assisting/promoting prostitution, which is defined as to solicit customers or transport persons for prostitution purposes; to own, manage, or operate a dwelling or other establishment for the purpose of providing a place where prostitution is performed; or to otherwise assist or promote prostitution.








Prostitution Offenses by Category

Prostitution Offenses Arrests By Age in 2019







Weapons Law Violations Count 5 Year Trend







Weapons Law Violations Arrests By Age in 2019






