For reporting purposes under the UCR/NIBRS rules and guidelines, all victims of crimes against society are classified as “society” victims. Individual data on persons directly and/or indirectly affected by a crime against society, such as pornography, is not collected.



- The unlawful cultivation, manufacture, distribution, sale, purchase, use, possession, transportation, or importation of any controlled drug or narcotic substance -






2007 Drug/Narcotic Violations

Drug/Alcohol Usage in 2007






**Adult Drug/Narcotic Arrests

These offenses are categorized under two types of criminal activity: 1) Prostitution, which is to unlawfully engage in sexual relations for profit. 2) Assisting/promoting prostitution, which is defined as to solicit customers or transport persons for prostitution purposes; to own, manage, or operate a dwelling or other establishment for the purpose of providing a place where prostitution is performed; or to otherwise assist or promote prostitution.





46.3% of the weapons identified in weapon law violations were firearms, of which 13.6% were classified as automatic.


