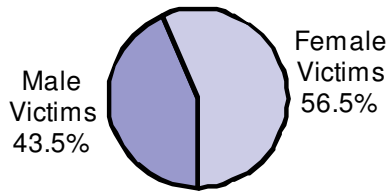

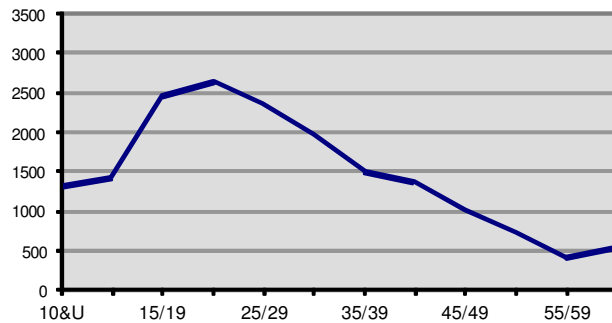

Crimes Against Persons in 2011 Gender Comparison



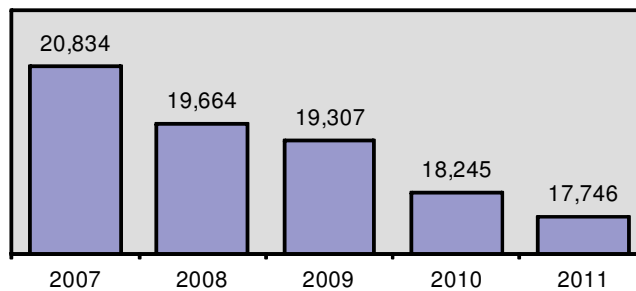
Victims of Crimes Against Persons by Age in 2011

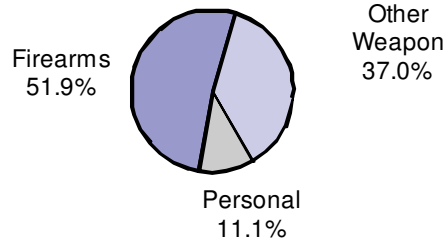

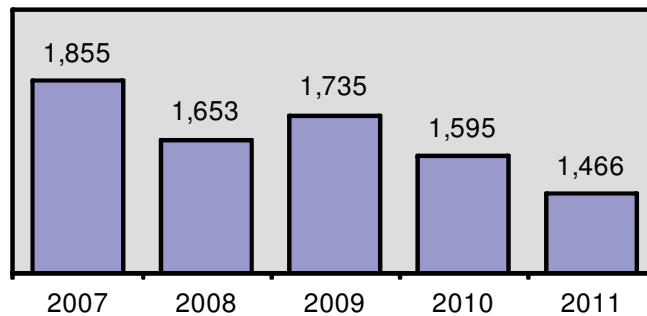

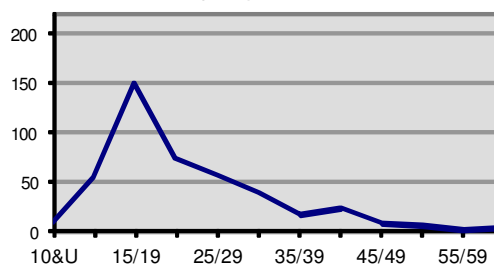

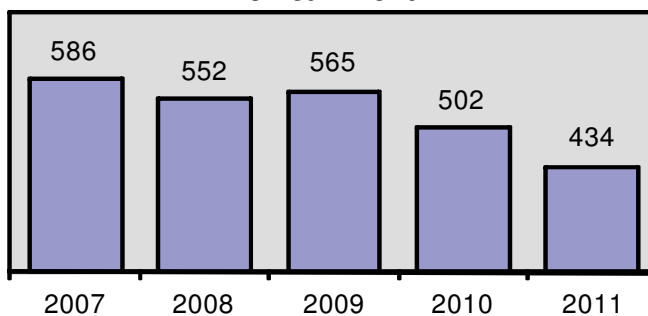

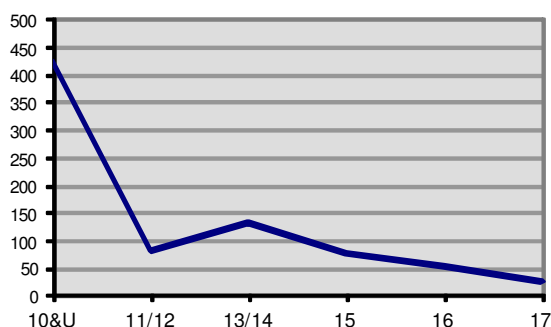

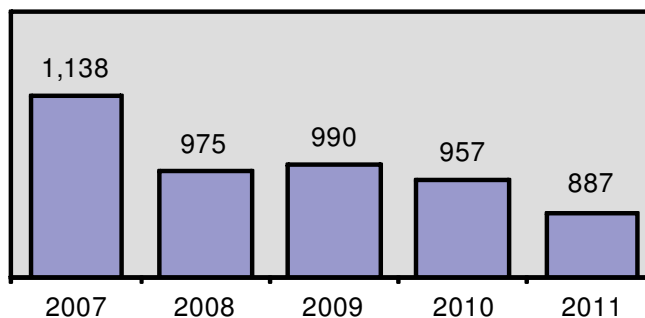

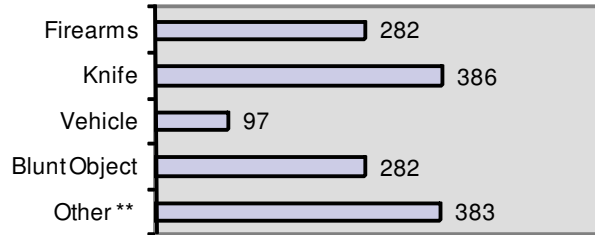

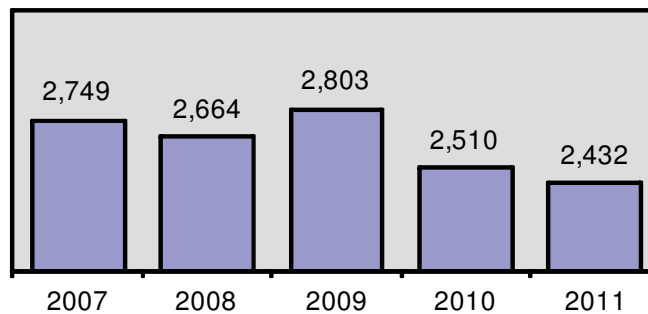

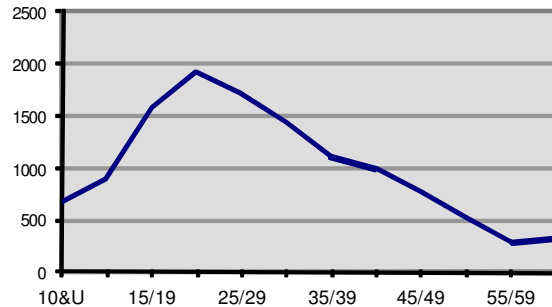

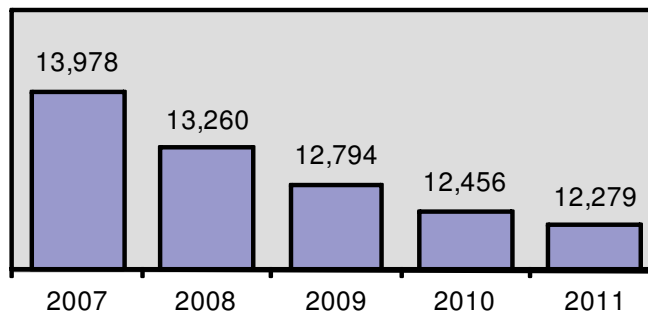

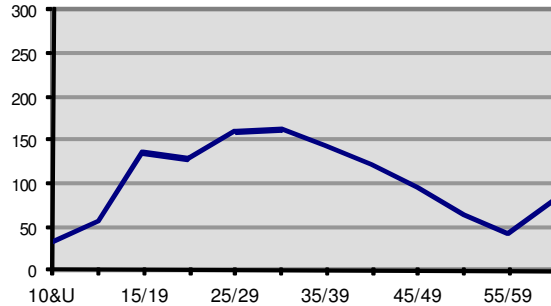

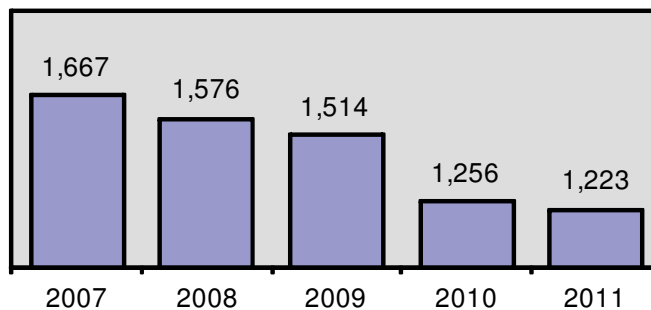

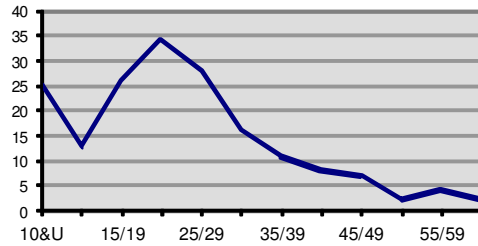

Therefore, for each offense of kidnapping, the victims are only the persons taken or detained against their will.

Kidnapping/Abduction Victims by Age in 2011



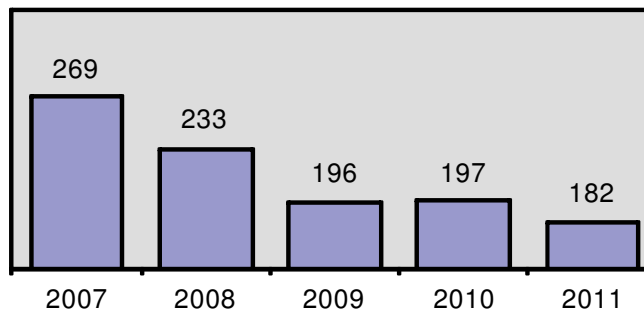
