





Gender Comparison




Victims of Crimes Against Persons



Deaths caused by negligence, suicide, accident, or justifiable homicide are not included in the offense of murder. Attempts and assaults to murder are classified as aggravated assaults and not as murder.

Murder Incidents by Type of Weapon Used in 2016

























Although the object of a kidnapping may be to obtain money or property, kidnapping is a crime against persons. This offense includes not only kidnapping and abduction, but hostage taking as well. This category is intended to capture information on only the persons actually kidnapped or abducted, not those persons or organizations paying ransoms. Therefore, for each offense of kidnapping, the victims are only the persons taken or detained against their will.


Kidnapping/Abduction Victims by Age in 2016
