





Frequency of Crime by Month









Rape Count - 5 Year Trend







Fondling Count - 5 Year Trend





Kidnapping


- The unlawful seizure, transportation, and/or detention of a person against his/her will, or a minor without the consent of his/her parent(s) or legal guardian -

Although the object of a kidnapping may be to obtain money or property, kidnapping is a crime against persons. This offense includes not only kidnapping and abduction, but hostage taking as well. This category is intended to capture information on only the persons actually kidnapped or abducted, not those persons or organizations paying ransoms. 



Kidnapping Count - 5 Year Trend









Aggravated Assault Count - 5 Year Trend









Simple Assault Count - 5 Year Trend








Intimidation Count - 5 Year Trend
