
Data counts represent the number of offenses within a reported incident





Arrests By Age in 2020







Adult Arrests Count 5 Year Trend







Drug/Narcotic Violations Arrests By Age in 2020




Usage of Drugs and/or Alcohol

3.28% decrease from last years suspected drug and/or alcohol usage during the commission of Group "A" offenses.




Drug Equipment Violations



Estimated Seized Value (in \$ 1,000s)









Gambling Offenses by Category










Pornography/Obscene Material Arrests By Age in 2020


- To unlawfully engage in or promote sexual activities for profit -


These offenses are categorized under two types of criminal activity: 1) Prostitution, which is to unlawfully engage in sexual relations for profit. 2) Assisting/promoting prostitution, which is defined as to solicit customers or transport persons for prostitution purposes; to own, manage, or operate a dwelling or other establishment for the purpose of providing a place where prostitution is performed; or to otherwise assist or promote prostitution.

Prostitution Offenses Arrests By Age in 2020






