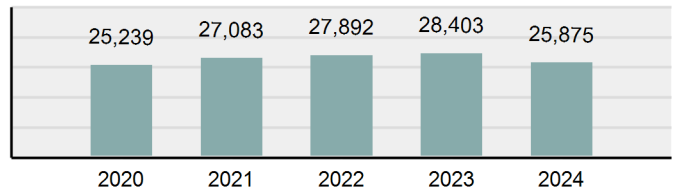
Data counts represent the number of offenses within a reported incident

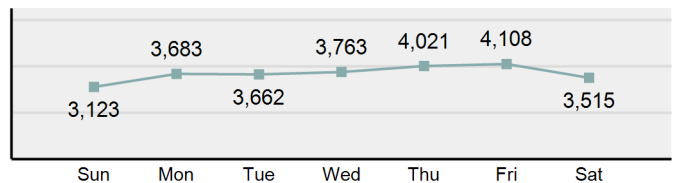

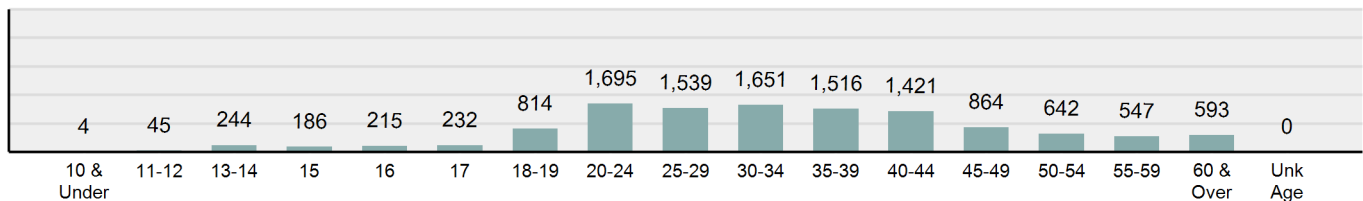

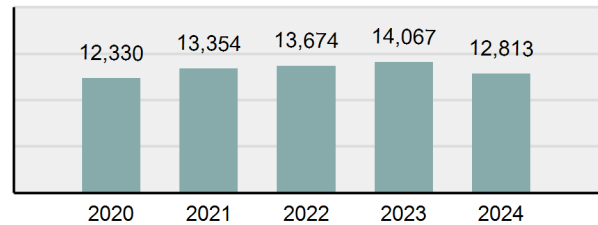

Drug/Narcotic Violations Count 5 Year Trend



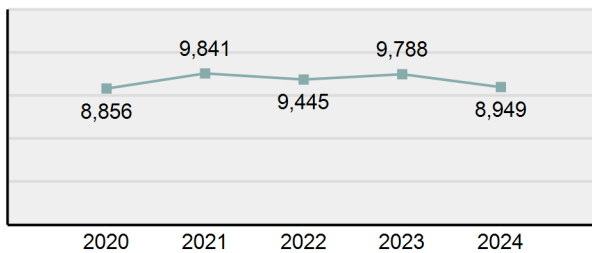

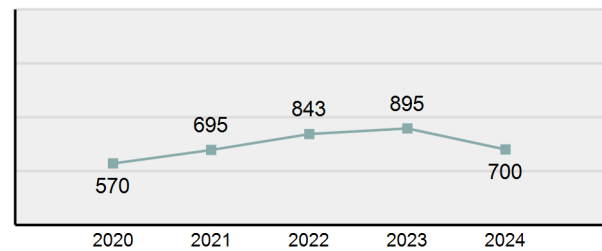

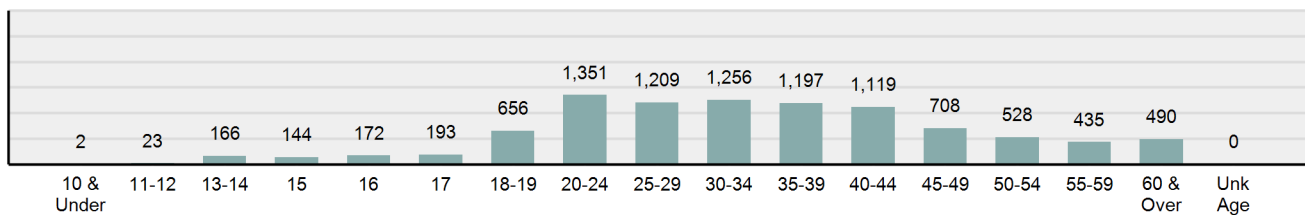
Adult Arrests Count 5 Year Trend

Drug/Narcotic Violations Arrests By Age in 2024



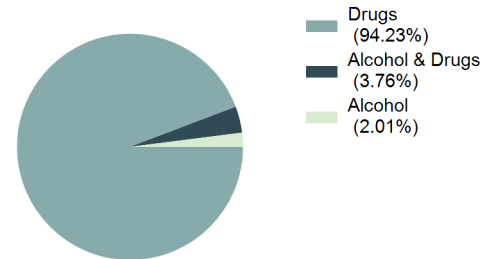

8.76% decrease from last years suspected drug and/or alcohol usage during the commission of Group "A" offenses.

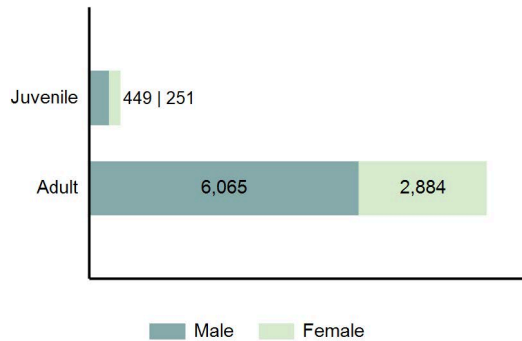

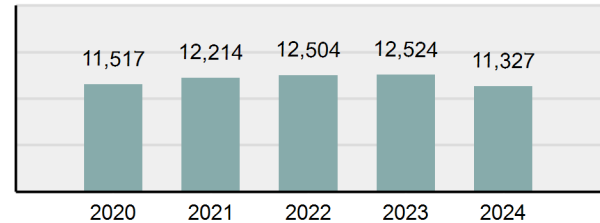

Drug Equipment Violations

- The unlawful manufacture, sale, purchase, possession, or transportation of equipment or devices utilized in preparing and/or using drugs or narcotics -
This offense includes the operation of 'meth labs.' Seized materials used to produce any illegal controlled substance would be classified under drug equipment violation.

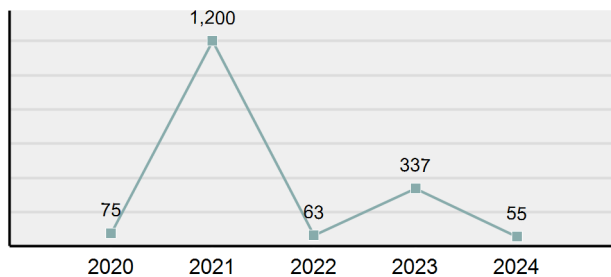

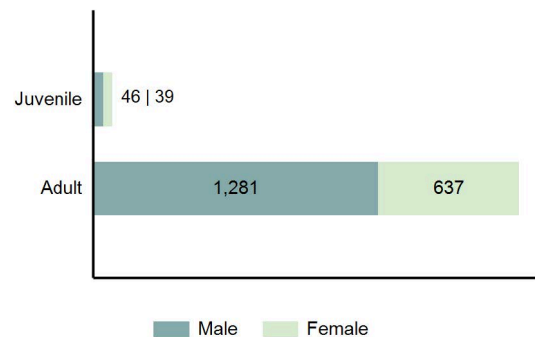

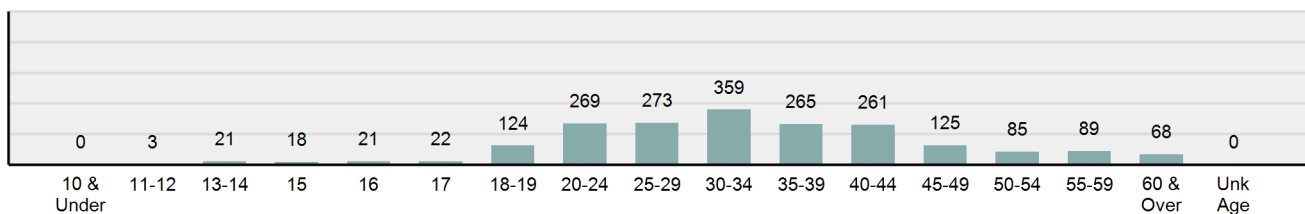
Estimated Seized Value (in \$ 1,000s)

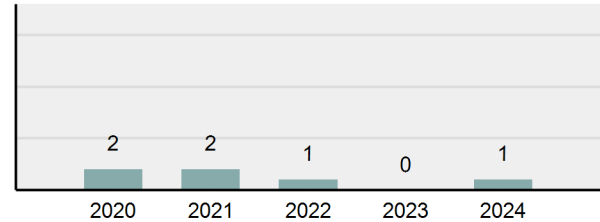

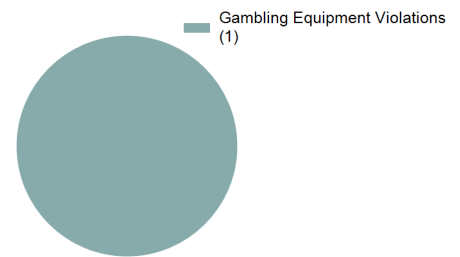
Gambling Offenses Count 5 Year Trend

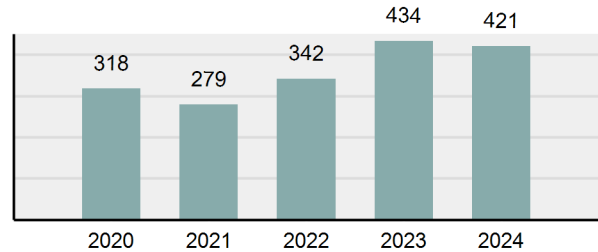

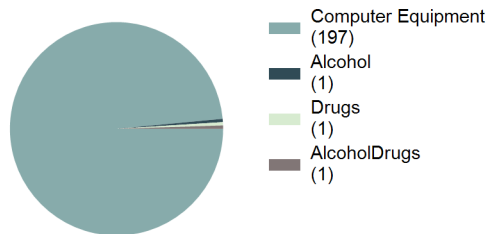

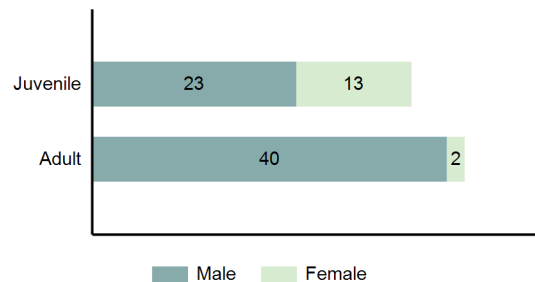

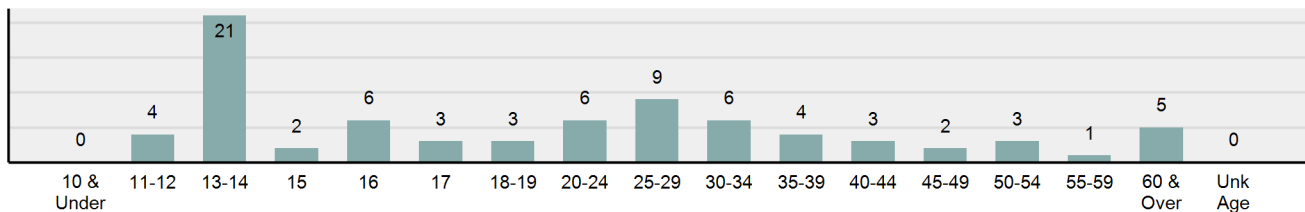
Pornography Offense by Category

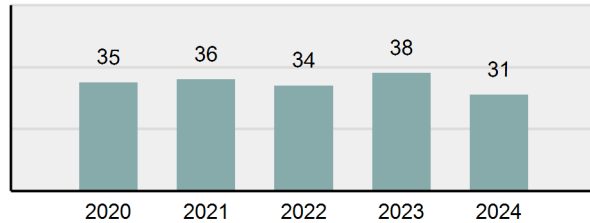
Prostitution Offenses

- To unlawfully engage in or promote sexual activities for profit -

These offenses are categorized under two types of criminal activity: 1) Prostitution, which is to unlawfully engage in sexual relations for profit. 2) Assisting/promoting prostitution, which is defined as to solicit customers or transport persons for prostitution purposes; to own, manage, or operate a dwelling or other establishment for the purpose of providing a place where prostitution is performed; or to otherwise assist or promote prostitution.

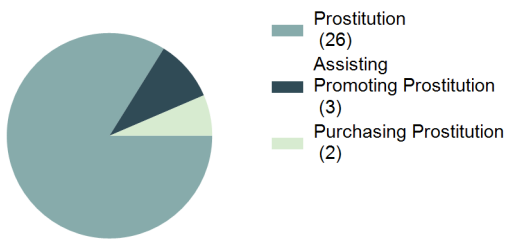

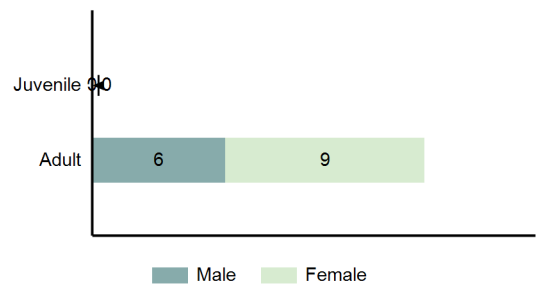

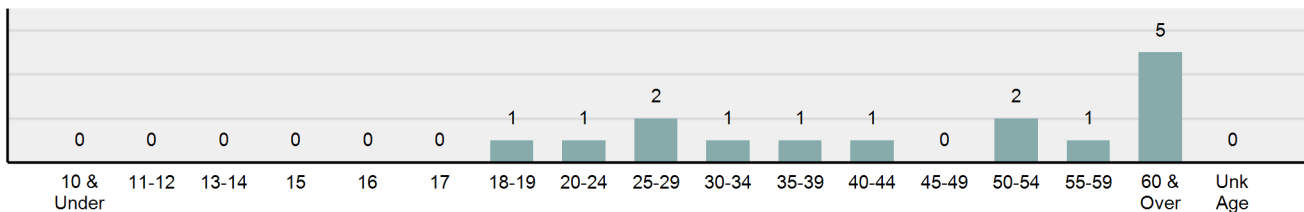
Prostitution Offenses by Category

Prostitution Offenses Arrests By Age in 2024

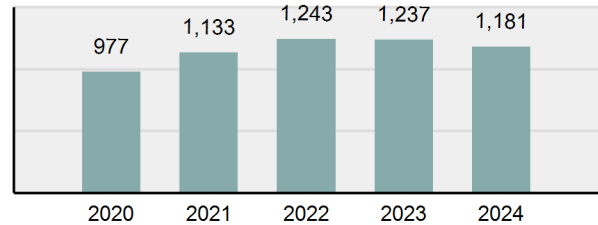

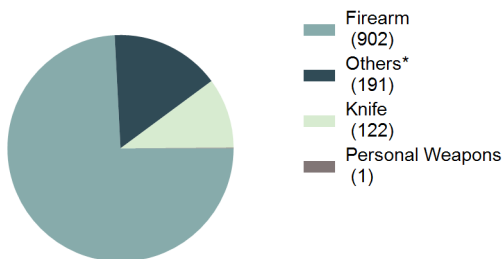

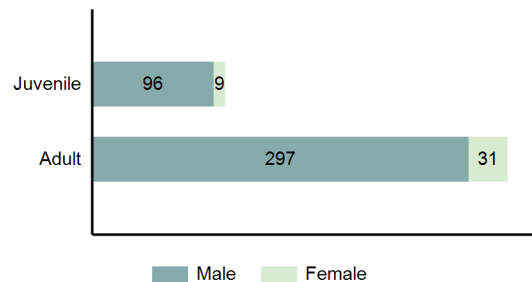

Type of Weapons Used

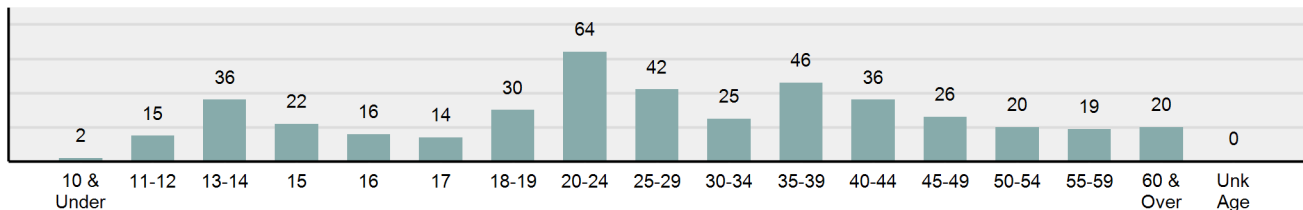

Weapons Law Violations Arrests By Age in 2024

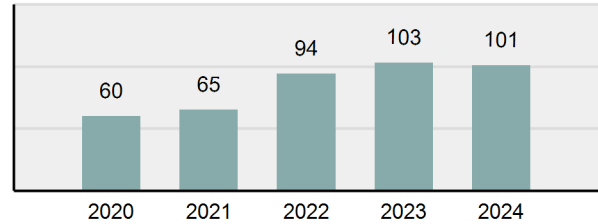
